## Early Care and Education



Our **Skip-a-Long Childhood Centers** are, perhaps, our most well-known program, with centers in Davenport, Milan, Moline, and Rock Island. Our centers serve children ages six weeks to 12 years old. They are nationally accredited, and our Illinois centers boast a Gold Circle rating, and our Iowa center holds a 3 on the IQ4K scale.

**Prevention Initiative** is our newest program, established in 2022. It is an intensive, research-based child development and family support service for families with children from birth to age three. It aims to build a strong early learning foundation and prepare children for later school success.



**Early Head Start Child Care Partnership** was established in 2021 to provide comprehensive services to low-income children and families. EHSCCP serves children age birth to three in centers, and birth to four in child care homes. Support includes health and nutrition, mental health, and parent, family, and community engagement.

**Home Child Care Network** supports families needing non-traditional hours of care (1st, 2nd, 3rd shifts, weekends, and holidays). HCCN works with licensed family child care providers to offer free support, supplies, and training resources so children in a home setting receive the same quality care as children in center-based programs.



## Stabilization



**Welcoming Center** provides services and supports for immigrants, refugees, and Limited English proficient individuals and families in Rock Island, Henry, and Mercer Counties. It offers support with advocacy, navigating housing, food, and clothing assistance, locating employment, and applying for and understanding Illinois state benefits.

## Resource & Referral

We operate two **Child Care Resource and Referral** programs, one based in the Quad Cities that covers Midwestern Illinois, and another based in Peoria that covers Central Illinois. CCR&Rs are dedicated to connect families needing quality, affordable child care with licensed providers.

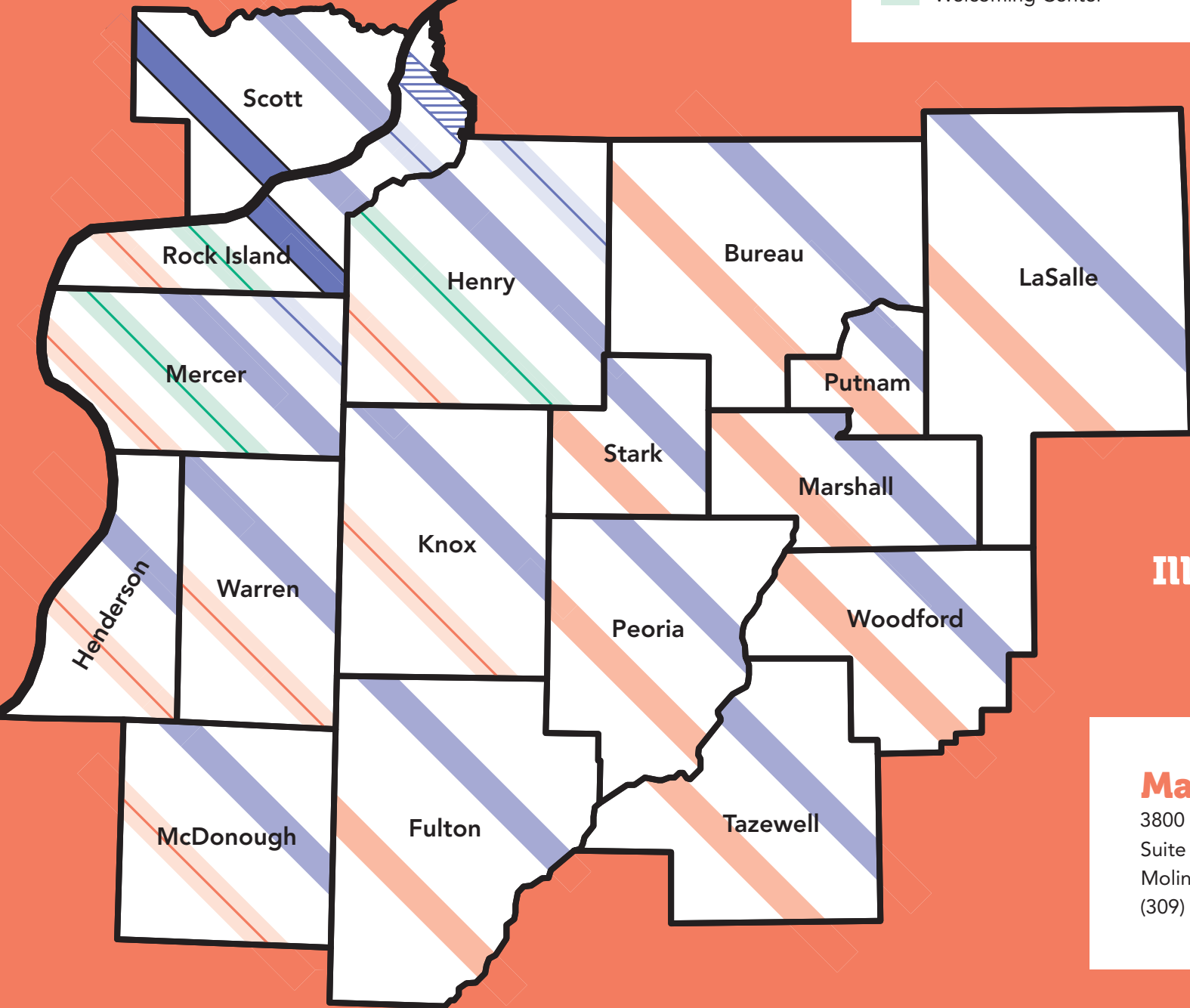
